Phonics - The start of Phase 3

We are looking at the digraphs 'ch', 'sh' and 'th' You could use the Phase 3 Jolly Phonics pages on you tube. You could also visit the Geraldine Giraffe pages too. There's lots of videos on youtube too looking at these digraphs such as https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q1rXsF-mXvM

Use your wooden letters to practise forming these Phase 3 words. Can you make the words: 'chop or chip', 'shop or ship', 'the or this'

Visit the website Starfall and practise reading some e-books together. Model blending and sounding out. Make a bingo game up together. Use some plain white paper and draw out a grid of 6 boxes. Adult to write a letter or one of the focus digraphs e.g. sh, ch or th inside each box – using a small toy or puppet, call out some letter sounds/ or the digraphs. If you have it then cross it off your Bingo board. Practise reading some simple captions together e.g. "fish and chips" "a big red ship" "three chops on a dish"
