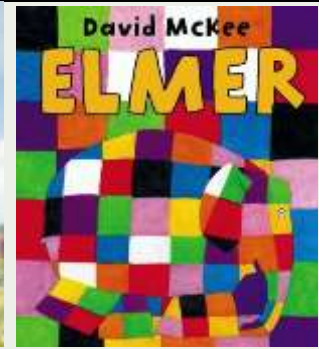
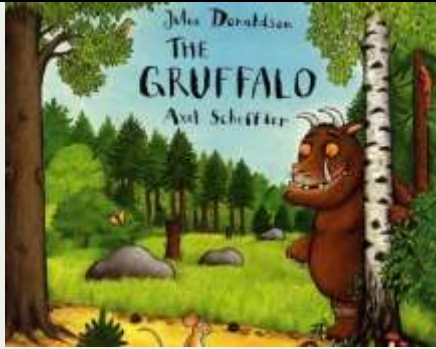


Foundation Stage – Autumn First Half

Key Knowledge for 'Me and My World':

To begin to develop their sense of time by looking at toys from the past

Key questions for Me and My World:

What is a friend? How do you be a good friend?	What happens in Autumn?
Do you look the same as people in your family? What about other families?	What do you like to do? Do you have any hobbies or favourite games to play?
What is a celebration? How do you celebrate birthdays in your family?	What toys did your grown ups play with when they were little?

Seasons
