Our Planet

Key Vocabulary:

History, past, now, a long time ago, transport, vehicle, bicycle, aeroplane. Planet, earth, recycling, materials, rubbish, sorting, positive, good, negative, bad, pollution, help, look after.

Key Vocabulary for Literacy and Maths this Half Term:

Literacy:

- *Digraph*: two phonemes that go together to make one sound, e.g. ch, ng, sh.
- *Trigraph*: three phonemes that go together to make one sound, e.g. igh, ear, air.
- *Vowel Sounds*: digraphs that make a vowel sound in a word, e.g.
- *Non-fiction*: a book that gives information rather than a story.

Maths:

- *Comparing*: which set of objects has more or less.
- *Composition*: how many different ways can we show 4, e.g. 1 and 3, 2 and 2.
- *Combining*: adding two groups together.
- *Length*
- *Height*
- *Seasons*
