


opportunity was to enhance their current topic of India. A detailed curriculum map outlining all of the topics covered at school is on the school web site in the curriculum tab.

Y6 Holocaust Survivor Webinar



The children in year 6 are learning about WW2 at this half term. They were lucky enough to take part in a webinar with the Holocaust survivor Peter Lantos (a Hungarian Holocaust survivor). Peter was awarded the British Empire Medal in 2020 for 'services to Holocaust education and awareness'. He is one of the last of the generation of survivors and has recently published a children's book which will serve as a testimony to his experience. He was born in Hungary and was imprisoned in Bergen Belson concentration camp. He sought sanctuary in the UK and became a neuroscientist He worked for the NHS and saved hundreds of lives due to his specialism in brain tumours and the nervous system.
