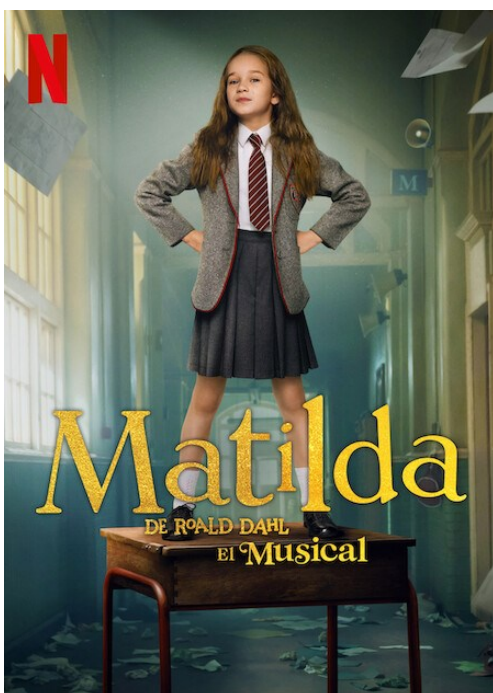
Play Leaders
